Mt. Assisi Place employs approximately 50 full- and part-time personnel. Our administrators, physicians, nurses, aides and other support staff get to know each Resident so that we may best meet their individual needs and specific care plans.

Although personal care facilities are not required to have nurses on staff, Mt. Assisi Place has full-time and part-time nurses available for the benefit of our Residents. Along with our aides, our nurses assist Residents with many day-to-day activities, and our activities coordinators organize a wide variety of enriching and entertaining events and activities for our Residents.

A physician is available on site weekly, and Residents also are encouraged to stay in touch with their personal doctors for medical advice. Excellent pharmaceutical support is available locally and by delivery.

Our Residents enjoy access to beauty and barber services, laundry and housekeeping services, our peaceful grounds, a full chapel with daily Mass, and unlimited visitation privileges, both on and off the property. Service & Safety
